







Buy American Act

Buy American Act

The Buy American Act requires the U.S. Government (and in certain situations state governments) to prefer U.S. made products in its purchases. Pursuant to this Act, a manufactured good used as construction material in a project funded by the federal government requires that a product be manufactured in the United States be more than 65% U.S. fabricated, assembled, materials, components and parts to be considered "Made in the U.S." for government procurement purposes (60% component cost requirement).
